- B. <u>02.13.2024 Minutes</u> Review & Approval (7:10-7:15)
 - Chuck Wocken approved
 - Althea Heim second it
- C. Updates of Committee Work (7:15-7:45)
 - 1. <u>Discipleship</u> (Jackie Popp)
 - Major point that as a committee want guidance from the ACC council as to what they should be doing and carry it forward.
 - Worked on goals by looking at what other parishes were doing and then had ideas that they wanted to do in their parish.
 - Mike and Julie Gillen got together to fill out charts and then set a time to meet again just the St. Stephen group.
 - Goals...to look at things critically and to find the gaps.
 - Althea mentioned that they broke up into small groups and decided who was in charge and how to fill in the gaps.
 - Discipleship committee talked about possibly moving some of the other committees together since some fell under the same umbrella such as stewardship, hospitality, etc.
 - 2. Young Adult (Jason Prigge)
 - They were meeting on April 11th to talk about Theology on Draft at Tequila Town.
 - Jason explained that when they were exploring for a site to meet they talked to Al Robles who spoke Spanish and helped them get a site discount at Tequila Town.
 - Alex Kramer stated that they are working on the Bishop's Pastoral Letter on the Eucharist
 and it was going well and they had good attendance which means they may need to
 order more books with the increased attendance.

- Jason talked about the Baptismal gathering and only 1 couple showed up. Repeated theme is once families get home they do not want to go out again.
- Father Tom had asked Jason what information they thought was useful from the Bishop's pastoral letter.
- One of the big things talked about was the Hallow App by Father Schmitz.
- Father Tom asked how formation connects participants with the parish communities and Jason felt those that attend do feel connected.
- Jason talked about some families who go church shopping and want to feel that they fit
 into a certain church community.
- Alex talked about Jason's backstory before he came here. In the past, there was a
 freelance young adult ministry when he wasn't here and then when Jason was hired
 those in the freelance group caused some drama and were asked to then play a smaller
 role.
- Kurt Stelton asked, "What are families looking for when shopping for a church?". Jason stated that most are looking for convenience.
- Alex Kramer says that she likes when they have door greeters to make you feel welcome.

3. Worship (Diane Blonigen)

- They haven't had a meeting so nothing new to present
- Father Ron had an idea to do 1 large Easter service for all parishes but too many people for one location.
- Formation activities for the ministers are on the back burner since covid but the Diocese is putting some things together for this with a focus on the spirituality of ministry.

4. Faith Formation (Kurt Stelton)

- 2 goals are Adult formation opportunities and Young Life Process.
- Adult formation goal is to set an activity for October 5th in the evening geared toward adults with an adult speaker, faith story shares and serving light apps and a cash bar.
- Young Life process they are seeking to pilot a Young Life model which the Bishop wants to gear it towards middle school age.
- Jason went to a young life process at the YMCA. The YMCA has a connection with that group and they get a room for free. Another option would be the Sartell community center.
- Jason would like to get a team of young adults together to pilot this program and then put together a video on how to embrace this mission.
- Alex Kramer said to list the events and where they are located so people feel it's not just for specific parishes but for any of them.
- A One in Christ event at Blackberry Ridge location for a social hour with light apps, possible trivia night for all parishes which gets all together for ideas and feedback for future events. Table set up for handouts.
- Jason noted to the ACC council that fine details are sometimes being left out on events such as the dates for Vacation Bible School etc. We need to work together to better communicate fine details before posting.
- Kurt stated that we still need personal contact to get people to show up.
