

We Remember

November has long been a time in our Church to remember those who have gone before us and we share with them the sure and certain hope of eternity with God made available through Jesus Christ. On November 1st, our Church celebrates the Solemnity of All Saints, followed on November 2nd with a Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, All Soul's Day. Each of these days provide the faithful a time to remember those whom they have loved and lost. However, it is not meant to be a sad time, rather a rejoicing in the promise of Jesus Christ of their salvation and ours.


The lives of the Saints are examples of Christian living; the challenges, the sorrows, the complete reliance on God and the joy and peace found in turning one's heart toward Jesus Christ.

I love the story of a small child overhearing her parents speaking about the saints, to which she replied, "Oh, I know the saints, we have them at our church." The parents looked at one another in amazement and asked her, "Who are the saints at our church?" She answered without pause, "They are the ones that the light shines through." She was, of course, talking about the stained-glass windows, yet how appropriate that she identified the saints as the ones among us that the Light of Christ shines through!

What did you learn from them and what do you treasure most in their memory?

This November each of our parishes will provide a "Book of Remembrance" in which to record the names of our loved ones, to lift them in prayer and to remember all the good they have done. Please take time during November to add your loved ones to the book and teach your children why we as faithful followers of Jesus Christ take part in these important rituals.



In the Creed we pray together at Mass, we pray that we believe in "the communion of saints", meaning that we believe we remain in relationship with all who have gone before us. We thank God for these people in our lives, both the Saints and those who were saints in the making. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in the peace. Amen.



For the People of our Parish

The Area Catholic Community of Mayhew Lake, Sauk Rapids, Sartell, and St. Stephen Updates for the hybrid meeting at St. Francis-Xavier and via Zoom on October 6th, 2020.

- Stewardship - Our four parishes have volunteers to help foster stewardship activities within their respective parish. As part of the larger ACC stewardship committee, they will begin by sharing ideas for education to the concepts of stewardship; giving thanks for and sharing all that God has given us.
- Young Adults - We are connecting with each parish to organize a unified Young Adult group to serve young adults from our 4 parishes.
- RCIA - Working to align RCIA and Baptism preparation classes within the 4 parishes.
- Evangelization - Volunteer representatives from our 4 parishes met to greet and meet each other, and to begin to organize as an "Evangelization team". The next goals are to establish a leader for this team as well as develop a letter to welcome everyone in our One in Christ ACC.
- Worship - A Mass schedule for the upcoming Holy Days is being developed for the period through New Year's Day.
- Parish Pastoral Council Engagement - Representatives from Our One in Christ ACC Council are meeting with their respective parish pastoral councils to "listen and learn". It is paramount that our Parish Pastoral Council is engaged and that we keep everyone informed of ACC activity progress; open communication is vital. At this time all four parishes will continue to have their own parish pastoral council and councils will continue to be invited to the conversation as recommendations are made by the St. Cloud Diocese.



COVID Update

Due to increasing numbers of positive tests in Stearns County and in the city of Sartell, it is necessary to restate guidelines for those attending Masses or other gatherings at St. Francis Xavier Church.

We are committed in union with Bishop Kettler to strictly adhere to the following:

Masks are REQUIRED and must be worn for the duration of the time you are in the church facility.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

Masks **MUST** cover both your nose and mouth. If you cannot, for any reason, wear a mask, you must not attend Mass or other on-site activities at this time.

We invite you to join us for Mass via livestream at 9:30 a.m. and for drive-thru Communion at 10:30 a.m. each Sunday.

A six-foot distance MUST be maintained at all times whether seated, standing or walking in the church facility.

For funerals, wakes and weddings, only household groups may share space, all others must maintain a six-foot distance whether standing or seated.

If the current trend in rising numbers continues, increased restrictions may become necessary. Watch for details.
