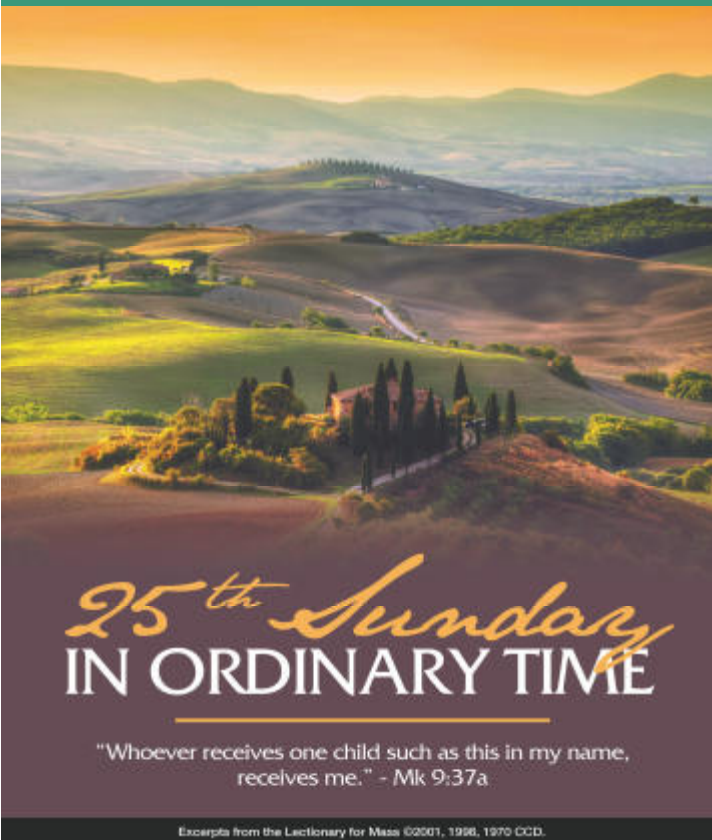

MINISTRY & LIFE PERSPECTIVES



Say the Word and My Soul Shall Be Healed

Provide the next phrase to this opening:
“Our Father, Who art in heaven ...”

That was pretty easy, right? You can do it because someone taught you the Lord’s Prayer, and the Hail Mary, and how to make the Sign of the Cross. You learned from another the seven sacraments, and how to go to confession, and why we get ashes. You and I and every believer was blessed to have a catechist to teach us things about God’s love and mercy revealed in Jesus and communicated to us through the working of the Holy Spirit.

This weekend we observe Catechetical Sunday, an annual expression of honor, gratitude, and prayer for those who accept this beautiful and pivotal role in the life of the Church. This year’s theme comes through the Gospel story of the healing of the centurion’s servant, words we use at every Mass: **“Say the Word and my soul shall be healed.”**

Two things are noteworthy about this theme. First, it is actually not a direct quote of the Gospel. Rather, the centurion says: “Lord, I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof; but only say the word and my servant will be healed.” In other words, the centurion is interceding for another, one whom in worldly terms is under his command. He transcends the relationship of master/servant and cares about the sick man as his brother. So too, our reception of Communion is not simply about our individual relationship with Jesus; it is about our communion with the whole Body of Christ. Welcoming the Lord “under our roof” – into our daily lives – is intrinsically about our relationships with other people.

So too, serving as a catechist reflects this selfless giving and focus on the other – seeing those being served as disciples whose potential to enrich the whole Body of Christ requires attention, time, gradual formation. Catechesis is not only about doctrines, history, and facts, although it includes them. Catechesis is about learning Jesus Christ, and that is about growing a relationship with Him, person to Person.

Second, the theme underscores the need for healing today. All too often we are wounded by anger, division, bitter rivalries, lack of civility and respect. While this is not new in history, of course, the Body of Christ always suffers from these conflicts and harms. Many are in need of physical health, but perhaps even more our communion in the Lord needs healing – relationships in families, workplaces, schools, neighborhoods, parishes, dioceses.

“Say the Word” – the theme teaches us that the Gospel brings wholeness and new life when we truly hear God’s Word above the din of human opinion and all the claims and counterclaims today.

Who taught you the Lord’s Prayer? Often the first seeds of faith are planted in family by parents and

grandparents, and so the Church recognizes parents as the primary educators of their children, and most essentially in matters of faith. Our parish programs are always only a support and auxiliary to that work of evangelization and catechesis that happens in the home. We are partners, not alternatives, for one another in this task.

We need more catechists – this year and every year – to respond to Christ’s call. Is He calling you? If you are hesitant, pray those words sincerely: “Only say the Word, and my soul shall be healed.”

Join me in praying for all who hand on the Faith:

Loving Father, we pray today for our catechists. We thank you for their gift of ministry in your Church. Grant them your wisdom that they may grow in the understanding and teaching of your Word. Grant them also your love that they may be fruitful heralds of your Word and lead others to love you. Pour forth your Holy Spirit upon them to grant them wisdom about what is important; knowledge of the truths of faith; understanding of their meaning; right judgment about how to apply them in life; courage to persevere even in the face of adversity; reverence before all that is sacred and holy; and that loving zeal which leads others to a transforming encounter with your Son. We pray this through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH

The Year of St. Joseph – A Father in the Shadows I

Pope Francis cites a book by the Polish writer Jan Dobraczynski, *The Shadow of the Father*, telling Joseph's story in the form of a novel. The "shadow" image refers to Joseph as the earthly shadow of the heavenly Father. Joseph was called to "cast the same shadow" as God the Father over the human nature of Jesus – watching over and protecting, teaching, guiding, and above all, loving this Child who had come into his life.

The Pope states: "A man does not become a father simply by bringing a child into the world, but by taking up the responsibility to care for that child. Whenever a man accepts responsibility for the life of another, in some way he becomes a father to that person."

This kind of protective fatherhood is not the hovering "helicopter parent" who intervenes to prevent every failure and hurt of the real world from impacting the child, but builds freedom, wisdom, resiliency, and character by letting the child make choices, experience consequences, and then drawing forth the lessons even of failure and opposition.

In this way, too, the title of the "most chaste" Joseph speaks to his freedom in his love for Jesus and Mary. Far more than some kind of physical restraint, "chastity" refers to the opposite of possessiveness. Chaste love allows the other to flourish in his or her own person, free to be the person God created them to be. This is the kind of love God has for each of us – without it, sin itself would not be possible – and it is a love which is not focused on the self but on the true good of the other.

How have you experienced love that allows you to be your own person through the care and support of another in your life?

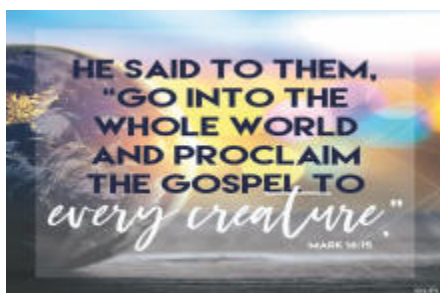
